### TBI Management in the Deployed Environment: The Concussion Care Center Model

#### Resources

1. The **Military Acute Concussion Evaluation** is a concussion screening tool for the acute assessment of service members involved in a potentially concussive event.
2. The **Concussion Management Algorithm** is a tool for all levels of providers on the assessment, evaluation, and treatment of concussion in the deployed setting.
3. The Departments of Veterans Affairs and Defense developed the **Clinical Practice Guideline for Management of Concussion/Mild Traumatic Brain Injury** to provide information about the assessment of symptoms and severity, treatment, symptom management, assessment of persistent symptoms, consultation, and referral and rehabilitation of patients with persistent post-concussion symptoms.
4. Subject matter experts from the Departments of Defense and Veterans Affairs developed the **Acute Concussion (mTBI) Educational Brochure** to educate deployed service members about TBI immediately following the injury.
5. Subject matter experts from the Departments of Defense and Veterans Affairs developed the **Concussion/mTBI Information Pamphlet – For Use >1 Month After Injury (Not Acute)** to educate deployed service members about TBI one month or more after the injury.
6. Academic experts, sports concussion clinicians and military TBI experts developed the **Progressive Return to Activity Following Acute Concussion/Mild Traumatic Brain Injury Guidance for the Primary Care Manager and Rehabilitation Manager in Deployed and Non-deployed Settings**. This guidance document includes the clinical recommendation, clinical support tool, provider educational slide deck, and patient education products.
